WHAT IS COOKIE?

Cookies are small text files that a website asks the user's browser to save on the user's system/device, when a user visits the website, to remember the user's device upon revisiting the website or during the session. Cookies set up by the domain Klearstack, are called first-party cookies and cookies set by other domain(s)

than the website(s) you are visiting are termed as third-party cookies. Third-party cookies are generally used for marketing and advertising purposes.

PURPOSE OF USING COOKIES?

Our website Klearstack (“We” or “Our” or “Website”) uses cookies and other tracking technologies for the following purposes:

1. To analyze your use of our website
2. For promotional and marketing purposes
3. To understand your preferences such as your preferred language
4. To deliver information that matches your interests.
5. To help us understand our audience and traffic patterns.
6. To let you automatically log into programs and parts of our site that require membership.
7. To manage and present the information displayed on our website.

Performance Cookies- Performance cookies are cookies used specifically for gathering data on how visitors use a website, which pages of a website are visited most often, or if they get error messages on web pages. These cookies monitor only the performance of the site as the user interacts with it. These cookies don't collect identifiable information on visitors, which means all the data collected is anonymous and only used to improve the functionality of a website.

Such cookies may or may not adhere to our policy and we cannot take ownership of said cookies, however, we would periodically and actively try to investigate them and categorize them in their respective cookie categories for the benefit of our users, partners, and customers.

Other tracking technologies like web beacons

Cookies are not the only way to recognize or track visitors on a website. We may use other similar technologies from time to time, like web beacons (sometimes called “tracking pixels” or “clear gifs”). These are tiny graphics files that contain a unique identifier that enables us to recognize when someone has visited our websites or opened an e-mail including these. In many instances, these technologies are reliant on cookies to function properly, and hence, declining cookies will impair their functioning.

How can I control the cookie preferences?

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. However, you may remove or reject cookies in your browser's settings. Removing or rejecting the cookies may affect the performance of the website.
